

## Home Family Worship with Kids 38. December 13<sup>th</sup>, 2020

### John 1:6-8 *Jesus the Light of the World*

**Message:** In the Bible reading for today, the writer of the Book says that there was a man names John, (John the Baptist) who was sent by God. He came to tell people about the Light. Through him all people could hear about the Light and Believe. John was not the Light, but he came to tell people about the Light. The true light was coming into the world. The true Light gives light to all.

Who is this Light that John was saying was coming? We know that Jesus is the Light. He is the one that came to take away the darkness in our world and be our guiding light to God the Father.

Maybe you can play a game where you are blindfolded and you are looking for someone who is hidden. Could you find the person hidden if you had to do it on your own? No. But having someone be your eyes, be your light you can find them. Maybe you can try finding something in the dark. Get someone to hide or hie something and you have to look for it. Without a torch or a light, it is very hard to find anything, but a light will help you.

Jesus is our light. He is the one who will be with us, to take us out of the darkness and into the light. The light that shows us how to connect and live with God for eternity.

**Activity:** You will need: copy of nativity silhouette on following page, Tissue paper or cellophane and Clear contact cut to A4 size

1. Cut up the cellophane or tissue paper into small squares and stick onto sticky side of the clear contact.

2. Cut out the silhouette and place over the covered contact. You may need to use some glue to hold it down.

3. Option 1: cover the picture with another piece of contact.

Option 2: Cut off the excess contact around the outside of the silhouette



3. Place the picture onto a window to allow the light to shine through.
