CONFESSION AND ABSOLUTION

We come before God as the Father who created and cares for us, the Son who died for us and gives us new life, and the Holy Spirit who brings us to faith and preserves us in our faith. We come to confess our sins and ask, in the name of Jesus, for His forgiveness.

as we forgive those who sin against us.

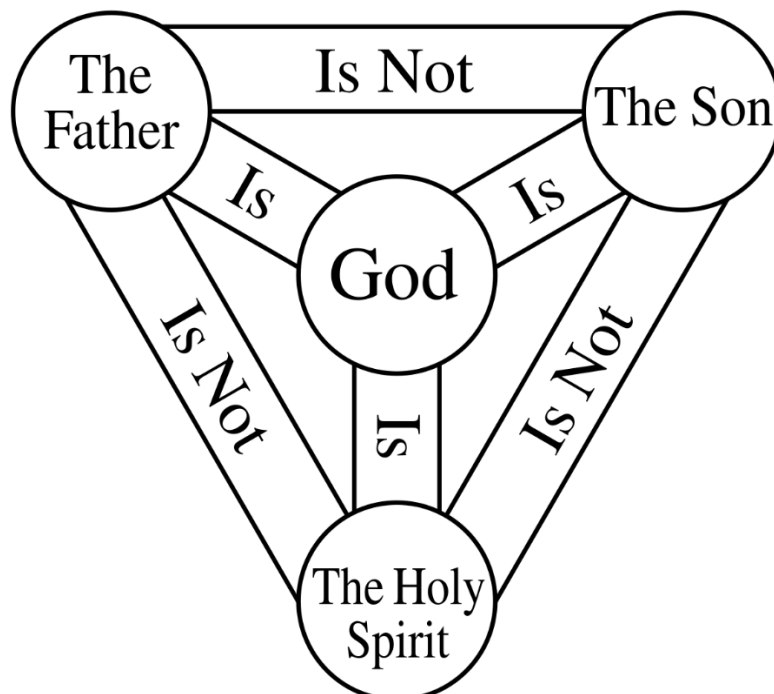
*Lead us not into temptation,
